- 1. Learning to be meek means trusting God first in all things
 - 1) Trusting God's heart and Word
 - 2) Trusting God in daily living
 - i. Self
 - ii. Others
 - iii. Temporary
 - iv. Eternal
- 2. Learning to be meek means living God-honoring character
 - 1) Honoring God in attitude and action
 - 2) Surrendering rights to God for His glory
 - 3) Modeling righteousness and truth to men
- 3. Learning to be meek means accepting God's blessings and provision
 - 1) Daily provision
 - 2) Covenant promises, i.e. the land, the earth, heaven
